# COUNTRY OR REGION

Bowed harp reached Estonia probably through the Swedes who settled in the islands and coastal areas of Estonia in the 1200s and 1300s.

# EL SEU NOM

En català, s'anomena arpa d'arc o arpa inclinada.

# CLASSIFICACIÓ

# MATERIALS OF CONSTRUCTION

The bowed harp is made of wood.

The strings are made of horsehair or sheep intestines. Also there are strings made of artificially nylon strings made of nylon stay better in tune and adjust well to the changes of temperature.

# DESCRIPCIÓ DE LA FORMA

Acostuma a tenir un cos semblant al de un violí però també pot ser rectangular, amb un marc sobre el cim que sosté les cordes.

Aquest instrument fa aproximadament 53 cm de llarg i 15 cm d' ample.

# HISTÒRIA

El seu nom es refereix a la forma distintiva, que pot ser semblant a la d'un violí o també pot ser de forma rectangular.

# TESSITURA

This instrument has only a scale of 6 notes with a humming that sounds continuous, it was use for dance music and calm melodies were too short.

In 21 of January, 2011 Krista and Raivo Kaustinen went to operate Iceland.

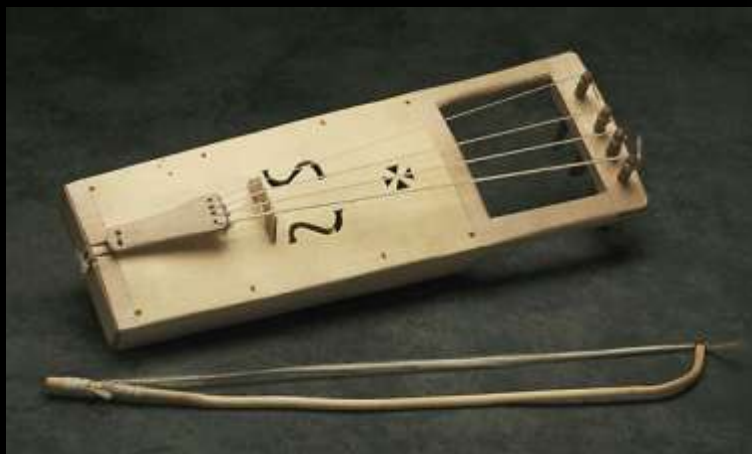
A school called Isafjörduri gave a concert in Estonia.
